

Life in a Pride

It is afternoon in Africa. Lions stretch and yawn. They live together in a group. It is called a pride. See how this pride lives.

A male lion is part of the pride. He guards the pride and their land. He has a loud roar. Other lions know to stay away.



A female lion is called a lioness.



The female lions in the pride are hunters. They also take care of the cubs. Cubs are young lions.

Cubs want to hunt. But they are too small.
So they play with other cubs. They practice
hunting. They bite, chase, and jump.



While the cubs play, the female lions hunt.
They work as a team. They look for prey
like buffalo. The buffalo will feed the pride.





Hunting takes a lot of energy. So does eating. Lions hunt and eat for only a few hours a day. They sleep for most of the day.

Together, lions are safe. Together, they are strong. Lions are the only big cats that live in groups. Living in a pride is good for lions.
