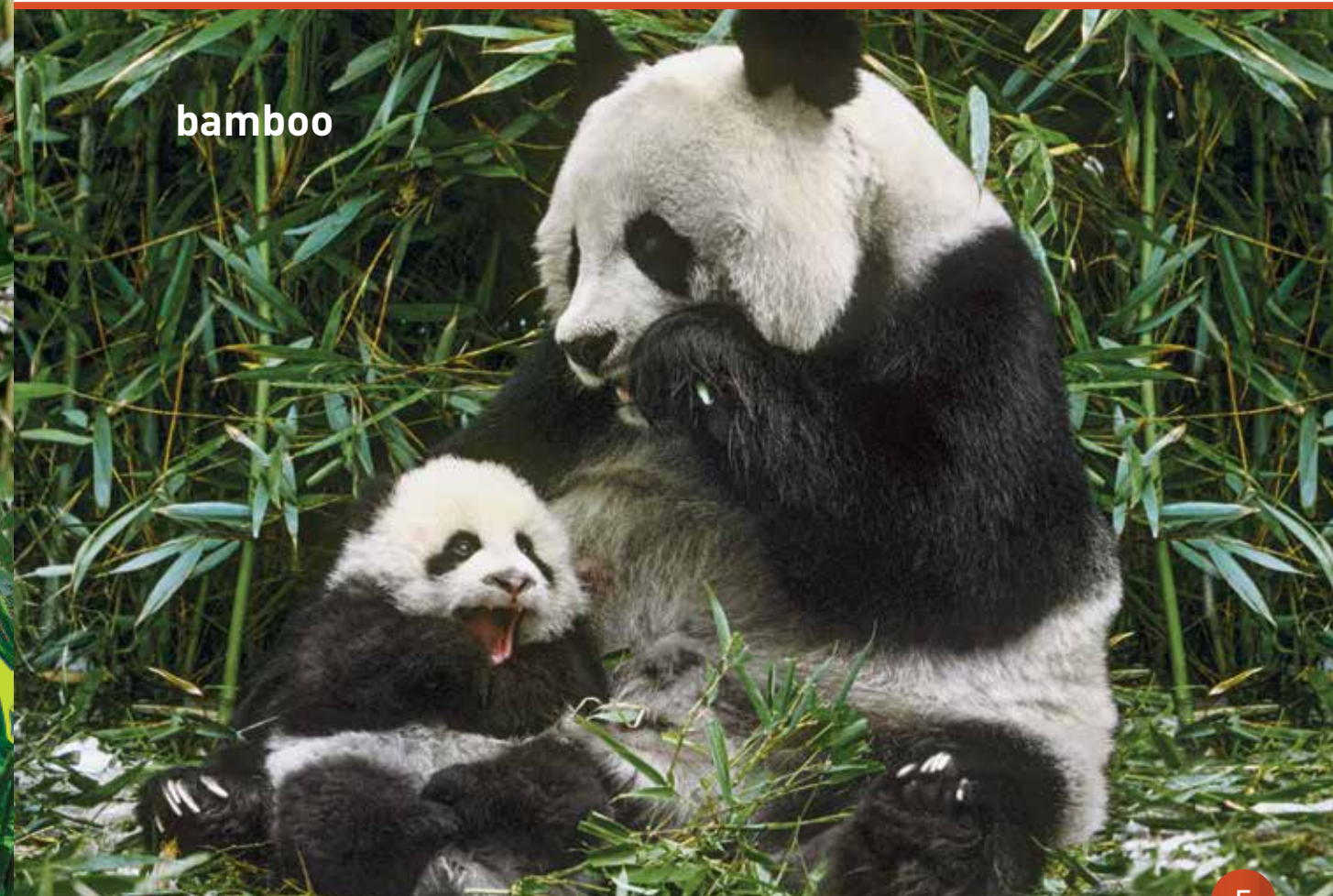
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The cub lives with his mother when he is small. His mother takes care of him. She also teaches him.
